

# Missions Update

Once again BCOB participated in Agricultural Workers Ministry (formerly known as the Migrant Ministry) in June. BCOB worked alongside the Savannah River Baptist Association, along with Grays Hill Baptist, Meadowbrook Baptist, Riverview Baptist and St. Helena Baptist. A work session was held in our Fellowship Hall to fill food baskets with the generous donations from our church family, along with others. Health kits were also created with personal hygiene items, as well as much needed liquid laundry detergent. Food baskets were delivered to several of the camps on two Saturdays in June, using one of our church buses. Health kits were distributed on two special Tuesday evenings events at the LeRoy E. Browne Health Center, sponsored by the Beaufort-Jasper-Hampton Comprehensive Health Services, who offer free health care to the agricultural workers as they move through our area.

Fiesta Night was held on Thursday, June 16th, hosted by St. Helena Baptist Church. Food, music, preaching and fellowship was enjoyed by more than 150 workers who were transported by buses provided by BCOB, Meadowbrook Baptist and Grays Hill Baptist. Next year we are planning to have services on multiple nights so that more of the workers can attend and hear God's word spoken in Spanish.

Thank you for your continued faithfulness to support this important ministry that has occurred for more than 46 years and is still going strong due to God's guidance and blessings.
