First, our local chapter of American Guild of Organists is putting on a fun **"Organ Spooktacular"** concert on our organ at 3pm on Sunday, October 2. This concert is geared towards children, but music lovers of all ages will enjoy the light music and costumes.

On **November 4 at 7pm** also in the Sanctuary, we will be hosting the **Spartina Consort** for a concert. Spartina Consort is a Charleston-based ensemble specialized in Early Music.
