BCOB Campus Safety Updates

One of the ways we "prepare for and care for" our church family is to do everything possible to ensure that our members and guests are safe while on the church campus. One of the challenges facing the BCOB Safety & Risk Management Committee is working to make the church campus as safe as possible without inconveniencing our members and guests. This effort requires balance, and the committee is grateful for your patience and grace as we work to make the campus safer. Beginning Sunday, November 5, a security team member will lock the balcony doors shortly after worship begins. You can still exit the locked balcony doors anytime during the service, but to re-enter the balcony, you will need to use the stairs inside the building close to the breezeway entrance. Once the service begins, the two front side doors (front porch) on the lower level of the Sanctuary will also be locked. You can still exit the lower level of the Sanctuary using any door. To re-enter the lower level, you will need to use the main center door on the front porch or enter the Sanctuary through the hallway of Building A. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we make our church campus safer for everyone.

Poinsettias

Beautiful live poinsettias have always had a place in adorning the sanctuary for Christmas and you are invited again this year to purchase plants, \$10 each, in honor or memory of either a loved one or a couple. If you wish, you may take the plant with you after the Greening ceremony on Sunday, Dec. 3, or, you may leave the plants you order in the sanctuary through the Christmas season.


Weekly Prayer List will be provided in The Happening, which you can receive weekly in your worship guide or at the church office. Thank you for praying and encouraging each other in prayer.
