The window project in Building B is complete! All ninety-one windows have been replaced and the building looks wonderful! Not only does Building B look better, we have also seen a change in our energy usage and, as a result, a drop in our utility bill. This project cost \$193,000 and currently we have raised \$160,000. We only have \$33,000 to go and \$14,000 of that has already been pledged. Thank you for your generosity and for being good stewards.
