Lenten Season

As we enter the season of Lent, we embark on a 40-day journey that prepares us for the celebration of Easter. Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday, invites us to reflect on our relationship with God, renew our commitment to Him, and grow in our faith as we draw closer to the sacrifice and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Let this Lenten season be a time of spiritual renewal for each of us—a time to return to the love and grace of God and to grow in our faith as we eagerly anticipate the joy of the resurrection.

May God bless you during this sacred season of Lent, and may it draw you ever closer to His love and mercy.

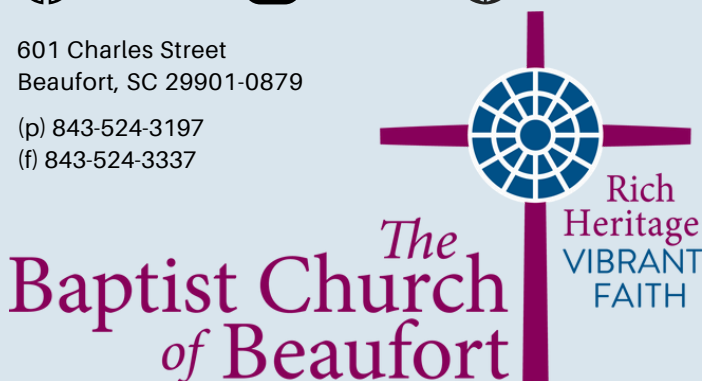
